- 5. Dressy attire for banquet (please no jeans). You will be introduced after lunch as you receive your CCGS All-State Award. Photo opportunity for parents after awards are given.

has been chosen to participate in the Colorado Coaches of Girls' Sports (CCGS) All-State Softball Games. The Games will take place on Sunday, November 2, at Christopher Fields behind the Westin Hotel in Westminster. The Opening Ceremony starts at 2:15. Games will begin at 2:45 with teams representing athletes from the 3A, 4A and 5A divisions on three fields.

CCGS began sponsoring an All-State Softball Game in 1986 to provide girls a showcase for talent. Each senior athlete is nominated by coaches in her league; while coaches representing all the leagues make the final selection of 72 athletes. Players are chosen based on talent, dedication, team play and leadership.

Directions to Christopher Fields:

- Coming South on I-25: Exit I-25 at 104th Avenue. West on 104th Avenue to Christopher Fields, just past Sheridan Avenue.
- ➤ Coming North on I-25: Take Hwy 36 (Boulder Turnpike) to 104th/Church Ranch exit. East on 104th. Fields are directly East of Westin Hotel.
